Terms and Conditions to be followed by the Exporters to get the Certificate from Director/ Commissioner of Horticulture, Government of Karnataka.

As per the Government of India notification, Dated: 28-10-2019, the following terms and conditions must be fulfilled by the exporter for the export of Bangalore Rose Onion from Chennai Port only.

1. Licenced Exporter must submit the application along with all the necessary details and documents to the office of Director/ Commissioner of Horticulture, Lalbagh, Bengaluru.
2. Valid Letter of Credit (LC) quoted for Bangalore Rose Onion in reference to Minimum Export Price (GoI notification No.19/2015-2020, dated: 13-09-2019) has to be submitted.
3. Freight on Board (F.O.B) value excluding freight charges and separate Freight Charges (FC) needs to be furnished.
4. Only after furnishing the application along with all the necessary documents exporter will be eligible to register and get the certificate from the Director/ Commissioner of Horticulture and same will be forwarded for the physical verification at the Chennai Port.
5. As per the Government of India notification, Dated: 28-10-2019, the export of Bangalore Rose Onion from Chennai Port will be allowed upto the maximum quantity of **9,000 MT till 30th November 2019.**
6. Eligibility of the exporters in issuing the certificate will be at the discretion of Director of Horticulture.
